postdoctoral fellowship

at the Center for Lifespan Psychology beginning June 1, 2010. The project investigates electrophysiological correlates of emotional pictures' perception.

The main tasks of the postdoctoral fellow include the implementation/development of experimental studies on visual perception of emotional pictures by application of electroencephalography (EEG), data analysis of biosignals, statistical analysis, preparation and publication of scientific manuscripts.

A successful applicant should have a doctoral degree in the Natural or Social Sciences, EEG experience, organizational and practical application skills on scientific investigation, excellent command of English (spoken and written), capacity to work independently and in a team, strong social skills.

The salary range is comparable with international standards for postdoctoral positions.
