- Authors should provide their abstract in Word format (Arial, 12 pt, Single space). **Title:** In Black and capital letter, **Abstract** in Arial 10. **Authors:** Last name and first letter of the name using comas between every author (in black). The name of the author who will present the work should be underlined e.g. **Rodeiro I**, Menendez R, Ramirez D, **Institutions, Addresses, E-mail.** Abstract should contain a **brief introduction, materials and methods, main results achieved in research, conclusions** and some reference if needed. 300 words maximum.
- The Congress program will be also printed and distributed with documentation on site.
- The lecturer should provide his full name, address of institution, e-mail, fax and telephone number.
- Facilities will be available in the Workshop sessions for computer-assisted presentations. You need to bring your presentation on a floppy disk (3.5 "/1.44 MB, no ZIP disk), on a CD, or on a flash memory using the USB port. Participants presenting with a Macintosh presentation are requested to use their own laptop, making sure the laptop has a VGA socket for sending images to the projector (external feed)

1. A letter of intention to attend the meeting
2. Curriculum vitae [Provide concise information in English in this order: Personal details, Academic degree, Previous awards (including grants and current fellowships), Publications. Independent courses and additional academic or research experience].
3. A brief points out on how you would benefit from this meeting.
4. Membership of International Society in connect with this field.
5. A letter of recommendation from the tutor or head of Dept.

Registration form and abstract must be also enclosed. To be eligible the applicant must be registered and the abstract submitted to the IWNI Organizing Committee.

Results of the application will be given for March 15th, 2011.
